

Creating a Compound in a Patient Chart

1. Navigate to the Patient Explorer Tab.
2. Click on the **eRX** icon on the horizontal menu.
3. Click on the magnifying glass next to the **Drug Name**.
4. Select **Compound** from the dropdown menu.
5. Select a Name for the **Compound**.
6. The user can free text the desired Ingredients after clicking the **blue +**.
7. The *Dispense Unit* dropdown is available for the user to make the proper selection.
8. Enter the Dispense Units in the dropdown as (Each or Unspecified.)
9. The user will have the option of adding *Instructions* by clicking on the **blue +**.
10. Enter the *Quantity*.
11. Enter the Instructions for the **Compound**.
12. Once the information has been properly entered, click **SAVE**.

(If you have multiple doses for the same compound you will need to create a compound per varying dose.)
